Dear Dr. Kadish:

After review of the requested progress report, the continuing accreditation status of the certificate and associate degree radiography program sponsored by Touro University was considered at the March 27, 2026 meeting of the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology (JRCERT). The JRCERT is the only agency recognized by the United States Department of Education (USDE) and the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) for the accreditation of traditional and distance delivery educational programs in radiography, radiation therapy, magnetic resonance, and medical dosimetry. The program was evaluated according to the **Standards for an Accredited Educational Program in Radiography (2021)**. The program now documents compliance with all relevant Standards; therefore, the JRCERT awards:

ACCREDITATION FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS.

Consistent with JRCERT Policy 10.100, this accreditation action is not subject to appeal.

This extension equates to an award of three years of accreditation effective from the date of the most recent site visit.

The next site visit is tentatively scheduled for the First Quarter of 2028. The continuing accreditation materials will be forwarded to the program at a future date and will include a submission timetable.

It is noted that the program's current five-year (2021-2025) average credentialing examination pass rate at first attempt within six months of graduation is 76% (168/220). While the program now documents compliance, the Board of Directors continues to have concerns regarding the program's accreditation history as it relates to the objective.


The program is advised that the Teach-Out Plan submitted on May 6, 2025, in support of the previous adverse action, is no longer applicable.

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The program is also advised that consistent with JRCERT Policy 11.600, the JRCERT reserves the right to conduct unannounced site visits to accredited programs. The sponsoring institution would be responsible for the expenses of any onsite evaluation.
